

CONDITIONS FOR SUPPLY & MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICITY TO ALL MARINA BERTHS AT THE SOUTHAMPTON BOAT SHOW 2010

- 01 . Marina sockets are standard 16 amp deck mounted, and will provide a maximum load of 3000 watts.
- 02 - All Exhibitors boat wiring and accessories must comply with the current I.E.E.Regulations, Local Authority conditions, the Health & Safety Executive and RCD directives.
- 03 - Multi-way socket outlets will not be permitted. One marina outlet is designed to supply power to one boat only.
- 04 - Electrical work by persons other than the official Electrical Contractor is prohibited. No person other than a member of **Solent Power Systems Limited** staff may alter or interfere with the installation.
- 05 - The prices in the Schedule include the hire of all wiring and fixtures. Any specific breakages or damage to the installation (including faults caused by Exhibitors' wiring or equipment) will be charged to the Exhibitor.
- 06 - If a marina outlet is required in a specific position, a plan must be sent to **Solent Power Systems Limited** at least 14 days before the Show opens. If no plan is provided, the Engineer will use his discretion as to their position. Any socket that has to be altered or moved will be at extra cost to the Exhibitor.
- 07 - This form must be returned to **Solent Power Systems Limited** by the closing date shown, together with full payment. Any orders received after the closing date will be subject to a surcharge of 25 percent.
- 08 - Power will generally be available for 24 hours during each day of the Show. It may be available during build-up but that is not guaranteed, and may be disrupted at any time until the opening day. Temporary power is not available for the purpose of stand construction etc.
- 09 - On the final day of the Show, power will be switched off approximately 30 minutes after the Show closes, or before if there is a possibility of danger arising due to Exhibitors leaving prematurely and causing disruption to the installation.
- 10 - **Solent Power Systems Limited** cannot be held responsible for failure to install an electricity supply or other items ordered, if the Exhibitor or other Contractors have not completed their work. The Exhibitor will be liable for payment in full for such items installed, even if late.
- 11 - All installations and connections will be at the discretion of the Engineer in charge.
- 12 - **Solent Power Systems Limited** cannot be held responsible for failure of electricity supplies under the control of the Supply Authorities, or for the failure of any mains producing generator sets.
- 13 - It may be necessary to disrupt the supply at any time for maintenance or safety reasons. This includes adverse weather or similar conditions not directly under the Electrical Contractor's control.
- 14 - As part of a temporary installation, all circuits are protected by residual current devices. These devices may trip occasionally due to the build-up of residual earth currents. Exhibitors are warned to take extra precautions to prevent loss of computer data etc. **Solent Power Systems Limited** cannot be held responsible for such loss.
- 15 . Exhibitors must ensure that all electronic equipment is tested to prevent the input of harmonic distortion back into the Boat Show supplies.
- 16 - No refund will be issued for work carried out as ordered by the Exhibitor.
- 17 - Any omissions to the Exhibitor's order must be notified to **Solent Power Systems Limited** site office in writing (or by fax / email) within 48 hours of the Show opening. Refunds will not be issued without such notification.
- 18 - **Solent Power Systems Limited** reserves the right to apply an administration charge to refunds in such cases where the work could not have been reasonably carried out.
- 19 - Due to the design and layout of the temporary installation, it may be necessary to position mains distribution panels at various positions on the marina. Any such positioning will be kept as discreet as safely possible.
- 20 - **Sharing of power between Exhibitors is strictly prohibited.**
- 21 - No claim for loss or expense (actual or expected) will be accepted as a result of the Electrical Contractor's failure to perform.
- 22 - Any payments received from outside of UK must be increased to allow for UK Bank charges.
- 23 . Upon completion of the installation, the Exhibitor will be required to sign a Test Sheet to confirm that all of their own electrical wiring and equipment is safe and has been properly installed / connected, and tested to ensure that no earth leakage is present.
- 24 . Any complaint about the electrical installation, the staff employed by **Solent Power Systems Limited**, or any other problem relating to the electrics at the Southampton Boat Show must be notified (in writing) to the Directors of **Solent Power Systems Limited** whilst still on site. A copy should also be directed to the Operations Director at National Boat Shows Limited.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN ELECTRICITY SUPPLY BEING WITHHELD OR DISCONNECTED.
